



Employees enrolled decreased 28.2%

#### **ENROLLMENT**

- Number of employees enrolled decreased 28.2% (12,499 to 8,970)
- Number of member enrolled decreased 27.7%
- There are 1,845 members enrolled who are 65 years of age or older

Paid Claims PEPY decreased 3.6%

#### **CLAIMS**

- Gross Paid Claims PEPY decreased 3.6% (\$17,089 to \$16,470)
- Average claim cost per year for Spouses decreased 5.9% (\$9,299 to \$8,755)

Generic fill rate 81%

#### **UTILIZATION**

- Musculoskeletal & Connective Tissue conditions is the highest clinical category (14% of medical spend and 35% above benchmark)
- Generic fill rate 81%, (BM is 89%)
- Therapeutic Class with the largest spend is for Diabetic Medicines



### **Finance Subcommittee Update Opportunities**

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What does the data tell us are areas of concern & opportunities for improvement?



#### Preventive Care Utilization

- There has been a slight rise in the cases per member <u>Cancer</u> claimants 16.6 to 17.1 members per 100 with cancer related claims.
- o 74% of Members had a Preventive Visit
- Men are worse offenders with only 53% compliance

#### **Know Your Numbers Campaign**

 Educational campaign regarding the importance of Preventive Care; checklist based on age/gender



#### Pharmacy Utilization

- Paid Rx claims are 29% of total costs;
   Benchmark is closer to 20-23%
- Generic utilization is 81% and benchmarks are 89%
- Average paid per employee per year increased by 6% and is 15% higher than PBD's Book of business

#### Save on Scripts

- Educational campaign surrounding cost savings strategies for prescriptions:
- Carrier Price Tools OneRx/GoodRx
- Generic vs. Brand
- · Mail Order vs. Retail





## Communications Subcommittee Update NY44 Visitors – December 2019 – February 2020


